


KPI Web Part Installation Instructions for SharePoint 2019

“Modern” Pages

- Download the web part (“SP2019” version) zip file from the product page on our website at <http://www.amrein.com/apps/page.asp?Q=5843>
- Deploy the farm solution as described in the instructions found on the product page.
- Extract the **aewebpart.sppkg** file contained in the downloaded zip file
- Upload the file to the Sharepoint App Catalog at “/sites/AppCatalog” (“Apps for SharePoint”). Please note that this step needs to be performed only once since all our web parts share the same App.
- You now can insert the “**AE Webpart**” web part onto a “modern” page:



- proceed to configure the web part:

Title:
enter the optional web part title

Web Part:
enter the web part name:
AEKPI

Configuration:
enter one or more web part configuration parameters (place each onto a separate line)
The available parameters are described on the corresponding product web page at <http://www.amrein.com/apps/chapter.asp?Q=468>

Height:
enter the optional web part height in pixels

License Key:
enter your Product License Key.
Leave this field empty if you are using the free 30 day evaluation version.
