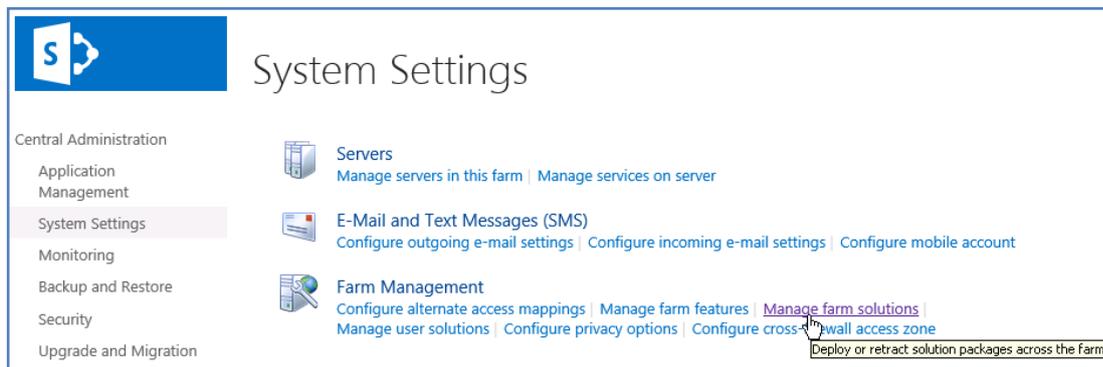


# AE Tabs Web Part

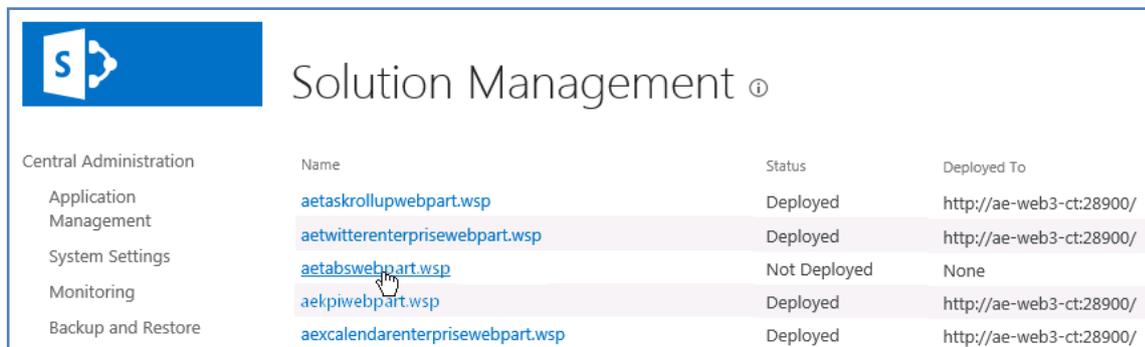
## Installation Instructions for Sharepoint 2013

### Automatic Installation

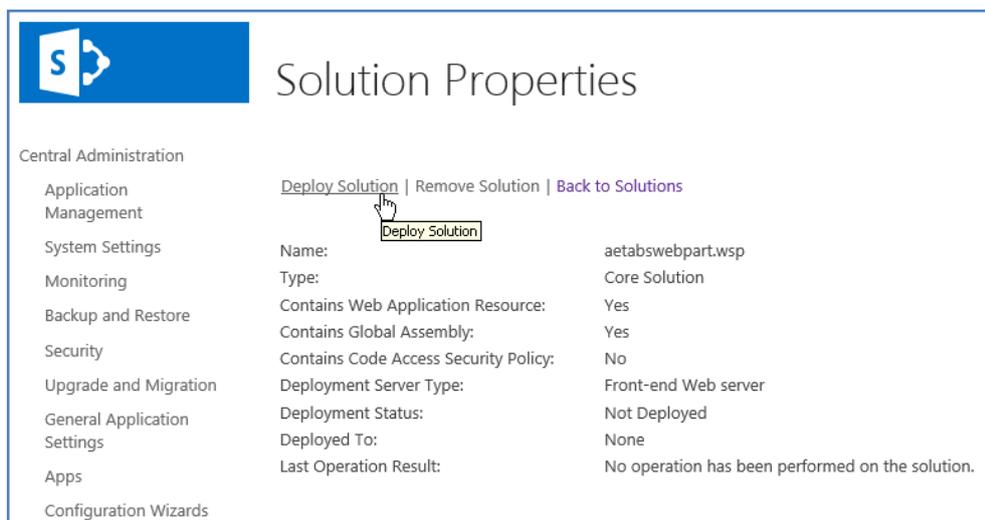
1. Unpack the **AETabsWebpart.wsp** and **Install2013.bat** files from the Zip Archive and place the 2 files onto your Sharepoint Server.
2. Add the Solution by either running **Install2013.bat** or manually entering:  
**stsadm -o addsolution -filename AETabsWebpart.wsp**
3. Deploy the solution by navigating with your browser to "Central Administration > System Settings > Farm Management > Manage farm solutions":



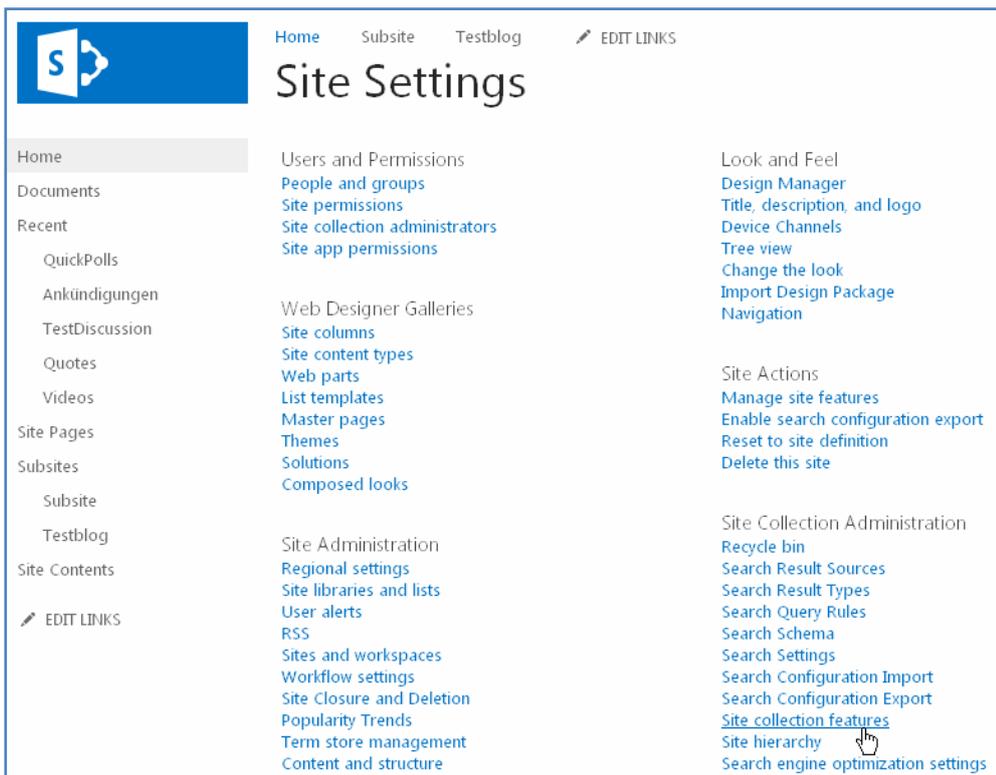
4. You should now see the **AETabsWebpart.wsp** in the farm's solution store:



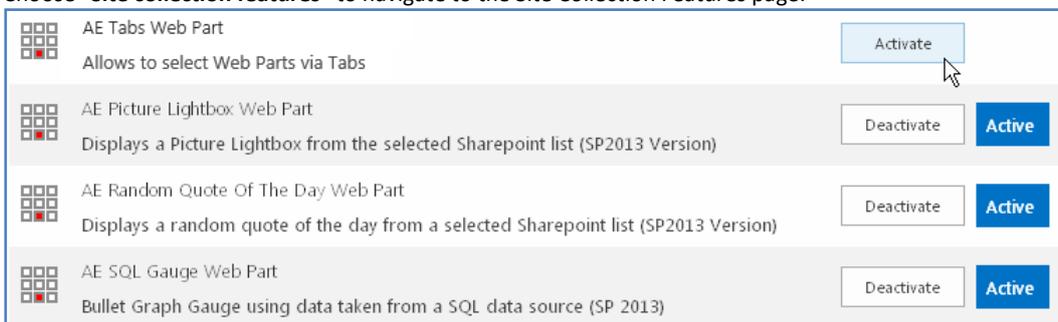
Click on "aetabswebpart.wsp" to deploy the solution:



5. Proceed to activate the feature by navigating to the “Site Actions/Site Settings” page in your top-level Sharepoint site:



Choose “Site collection features” to navigate to the Site Collection Features page:

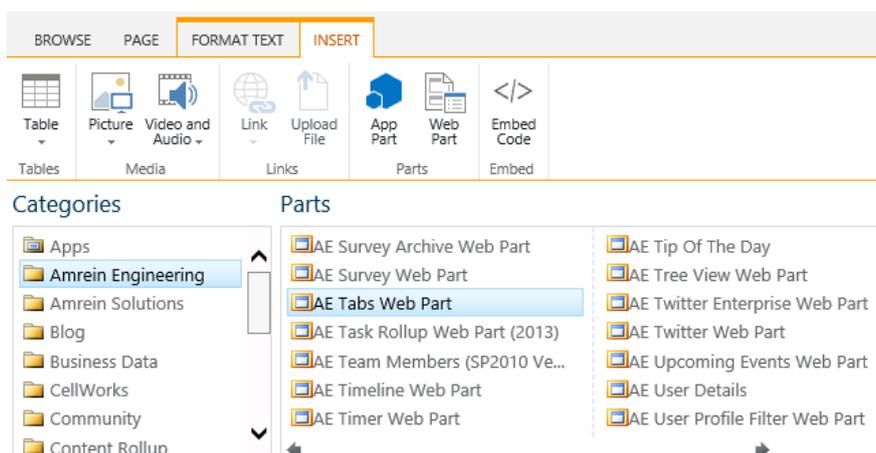


Activate the “AE Tabs Web Part” feature

## Adding the Web Part to a Page

Navigate to a page where you would like to place the web part and choose "Site Actions/Edit Page"

Select “Web Part” form the “INSERT” tab in the ribbon and add the selected web part to the appropriate zone. The web part is listed in the "Amrein Engineering" gallery section:



## Configure the web part settings:

### Tabs CSS Style:

enter the CSS styles to be applied to each tab as for example:  
`padding:5px;color:white;border-right:2px solid white`

### Tab Background Color:

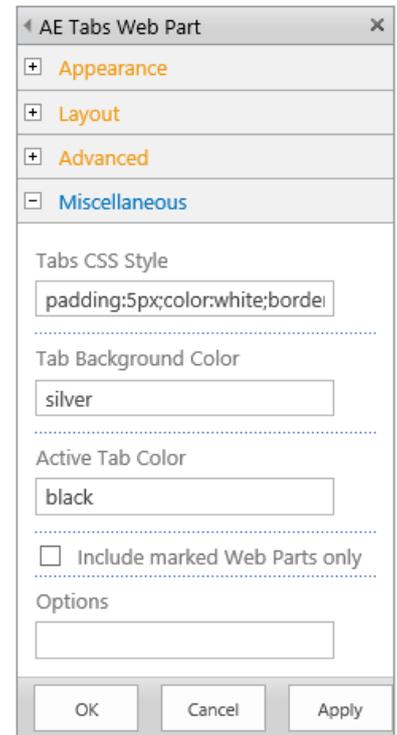
enter the background color for the tabs.

### Active Tab Color:

enter the background color for the currently active (selected) tab.

### Include marked Web Parts only:

adds only the web parts specifically flagged as described below to the tab menu strip.  
Flag a web part for inclusion by prefixing the web part's "Title" property with an "@" character.
