## **Description**

The free Christmas Web Part allows you to display a Christmas Greeting Card with animated snowfall on your Sharepoint pages

The Web Part can be used with Windows Sharepoint Services V3, MOSS 2007 and SP 2010.

The following parameters can be configured:

- Card Heading and Text
- Background Image
- Motif

## **Prerequisites**

Before you attempt to install the solutions you need to make sure that you have the following installed on your server(s):

• Microsoft Office SharePoint 2010 Server or Sharepoint 2010 Foundation

## Installation

#### Manual Installation

- 1. download and unpack the **AEXmasWebpart.zip** file. The ZIP archive contains the AEXmasWebpart.dll and the AEXmas.webpart files.
- 2. drop the AEXmasWebpart.dll into the GAC of your Sharepoint server (c:\windows\assembly).
- 3. add the following line to the "<SafeControls>" section of your Web.Config file. Please make sure that the line is added as one single line (no line breaks):

<SafeControl Assembly="AEXmasWebpart, Version=1.0.0.0, Culture=neutral, PublicKeyToken=c2143acde027eb31" Namespace="AEXmasWebpart" TypeName="\*" Safe="True" />

- 4. from the top site go to "Site Actions/Site Settings/Modify All Site Settings/Galleries/Web Parts"
- 5. use the "Upload" menu option to upload the AEXmas.webpart file.

### Automatic Installation

- 1. Unpack the **AEXmasWebpart.wsp** and **install2010.bat** files from the Zip Archive and place the 2 files onto your Sharepoint Server.
- Add the Solution by either running Install2010.bat or manually entering: stsadm -o addsolution -filename AEXmasWebpart.wsp
- 3. Deploy the solution by navigating with your browser to "Central Administration > System Settings > Farm Management > Manage farm solutions
