

Installation and usage notes for the Agenda/X Outlook Set Folder Language add-on

Purpose

The Outlook Set Folder Language Utility is an add-on to the Agenda/X Corporate Calendar product. It is used to set the names of the Outlook default folders to a different language.

Some mailbox agents or other Exchange add-on products create the default Outlook folders in English, if the mailbox has never been accessed by Outlook and the folders therefore don't exist. This behavior is not desired if users are working with international versions of Outlook, as e.g. German or French clients.

The Outlook Set Folder Language Utility lets you rename the default Outlook folder names of one or multiple mailboxes into another language.

Supported languages

Currently, the following languages are supported:

- English
- German
- French
- Swedish
- Spanish
- Italian
- Dutch
- Danish

Other languages will be added in the future upon demand.

Preparation

As this utility attempts to access mailboxes for which you might not have access, you need to logon with the Exchange Service Account to your computer. This is the account you specified when you installed Microsoft Exchange. If you are unsure about this account, run Microsoft Exchange Administrator, select the 'Configuration' Container, and hit ALT+ENTER, select the 'Service Account Password' tab and note the 'Account name' setting.

Please also ensure that you are running the utility on a computer that has an Outlook Profile already set up or where one can be set up to log on to Exchange Server. The utility needs an Outlook Profile to access Exchange Address book information.

Please note that CDO (Collaboration Data Objects) Version 1.2 must be installed on the system where you run this utility. CDO is part of Microsoft Outlook and not installed by default. To install, perform a

custom Outlook setup.

Running the OLSetFolderLanguage.exe program

After starting the Outlook Set Folder Language utility, you can select whether you want to read the Global Address List or a selected Addressbook- Container to browse for mailboxes. If you select the second option, a dialog box will appear to select an Address Book Container. Then, you will see a list of mailboxes in the upper half of the screen, and a list of available languages in the lower half. Select the mailboxes you want to set to a different language (use SHIFT and/or CTRL to select multiple mailboxes) and select the language desired, then click 'Set'.
